



ELDER STREET PARK & RIDE

As Downtown continues to mature and thrive, parking supply needs to evolve with it. Partners across the city, including the City of Boise, CCDC, Boise State University and Valley Regional Transit have been working on viable alternatives for downtown employees. The first alternative option is the **Elder Street Park & Ride**.

PILOT PROGRAM

- **COST:** To offer more options to get to and around downtown, the Elder Street Park & Ride will be **free** to use for all downtown employees between June 2017 – August 2017
- **LOCATION:** 2891 Elder Street | Boise, ID 83705
- **FREQUENCY:** Monday – Friday, 6 a.m. – 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. – 7 p.m.
- **EMERGENCIES:** Riders will be offered a taxi voucher in case of an emergency, or if they miss the last shuttle due to work
- **SIGN-UP:** Create an account and register vehicle through Boise State University's website
