

FRONT/MYRTLE/BROADWAY REPAVING

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is repaving Front Street, Myrtle Street and Broadway Avenue (U.S. 20) in the summer and fall of 2017.

PROJECT SCHEDULE DATES MAY CHANGE BASED ON WEATHER CONDITIONS.



AUGUST – OCTOBER

Reconstruct pedestrian ramps throughout the project area.

MID-AUGUST – SEPTEMBER

Broadway Avenue construction.

SEPTEMBER – OCTOBER

Front Street construction.

SEPTEMBER – OCTOBER

Myrtle Street construction.

NOVEMBER

Expected completion.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

The majority of construction will be scheduled on week nights to keep all lanes open during the day. Please plan ahead and choose alternate routes when possible.

- Each road will be under construction for about four weeks.
- During work on Front and Myrtle streets, two lanes will be open at night.
- During work on Broadway Avenue, one lane will be open in both directions at night.
- All lanes will be open during the day. Motorists may drive on a rough surface.
- Pedestrians will be detoured 24/7 while curb ramps are under construction.
- ITD will work to notify businesses when nighttime paving will temporarily block driveways (up to two hours).
- Some nights may require detours or flagging at signals.
- Construction will be noisy.



ITD will replace 78 curb ramps as a part of this project. The new ramps will meet current requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). ADA curb ramps are designed to safely accommodate wheelchairs and pedestrians with low vision.
