

Proposed Pricing Schedule


Electric-assist bikes		
e-bike minimum (to unlock)	\$1	\$1 to start
e-bike per minute (Pay as You Go)	\$0.15	From the 1st minute
Monthly membership	\$39	One hour of free ride time daily – no unlock fee - additional time at PAYG
Annual membership	\$99	One hour of free ride time daily – no unlock fee – additional time at PAYG
Student Annual membership	\$49	One hour of free ride time daily – no unlock fee - additional time at PAYG
Out of hub fee	\$2	Every time a bike is locked away from a designated station hub.





Scenario one – Drop provides bikes VRT covers operations

300 BIKES = \$450,000 VRT covers operations - \$370,000 VRT revenue share - 25%



Scenario two – VRT buys bikes VRT covers operations

300 BIKES = \$450,000 VRT covers operations - \$370,000 VRT revenue share - 75%



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



EV CHARGING Plug Types

LEVEL 1 120 Volt

- Ideal for overnight slow charging
- Ideal for short commutes
- · Plug into a standard wall outlet



LEVEL 2 240 Volt

- Ideal for workplace and destination charging
- Provides a full charge for most EVs in:



100% Electric

4-8 hours to full charge

- Average install cost: \$5,000-\$10,000




