




- 11<sup>th</sup> Street is an essential link in citywide bicycle network

- Premiere all ages, all abilities protected bikeway








## 11TH STREET STREETSCAPE ENHANCEMENTS

#### Concept 1 – Standard Streetscape




#### Concept 2 – Urban Canopy




