

Old Boise Blocks Visitation and Use




Why respondents visit the Old Boise Blocks of Downtown



Which historic and cultural themes should be a focus of this public space design (select your top 3)






- Respondents were very excited about celebrating the culture and history of the area Celebrate with a strong desire to be inclusive of and complement the Basque Block.


