



Resolution 1936 - Reimbursement Resolution



Budget and Financing

- \$36 \$40 Million estimated costs
- Financing with cash and bond proceeds



Resolution 1936 - Reimbursement Resolution



What is it?

A reimbursement resolution would allow the Agency, as an issuer of tax-exempt bonds, to reimburse itself for capital expenditures made prior to the issuance of the bonds, provided certain regulations are followed.

Resolution 1936 – Reimbursement Resolution



Key Takeaway

A reimbursement resolution does <u>not</u> commit the Agency to issue tax-exempt bonds, or to reimburse itself from proceeds of indebtedness at any point in the future.

Rather, it provides <u>flexibility</u> for the Agency to reimburse itself from the bond proceeds of tax-exempt bonds for prior expenditures related to the Project.
